  - Section 9.8.8.5. Openings in Guards





Furthermore, all fastener connections represented on the VISTA Cable Railing System sealed drawings, dated April 7, 2017, are in compliance with the aforementioned building codes load requirements. For additional details for acceptable guardrail mounting configurations and layouts, refer to the 8<sup>th</sup> edition of the ProBuilt and VISTA Design Manuals.

The seals applied are current for the details and tables assembled for the codes indicated above. Annual resealing of these documents is not necessary.
